Shelly Svoboda is dedicated to teaching the passion and joy of dance. Ms Svoboda began her training with Robert Irwin in Corvallis, Oregon. Later in Lansing, Michigan, she studied with Virgiline Simmons, the president of the Cecchetti Council of America. Upon high school graduation, she continued her dance training with the Royal Winnipeg Ballet professional training program.

Later returning to Corvallis to visit family, Ms Svoboda connected with the Eugene Ballet Company, where she was a member for six years. In 1987, Ms Svoboda purchased The Corvallis School of Ballet from Tom Irwin, renaming the school The Regional School of Ballet.

Ms Svoboda continues to train as a teacher with such renowned instructors as David Howard, Michael Owens, Mary Price Boday, Pacific Northwest Ballet Company Instructors' Program, Karen Clippenger, and the Royal Winnipeg Ballet Professional Teachers Training Program. She is a member of the American Academy of Ballet.

The studio emphasizes the American West Coast syllabus and schools each dancer in the benefits of having a professional attitude in dance. Ms Svoboda's goal is to provide a positive, safe, and effective environment to train.

Studio Dress Code

The Regional School of Ballet Dress Code is designed to teach students discipline and to help with overall focus and energy. The dress code minimizes distractions and creates a uniformed class look and allows the teachers to see and correct the dancer's alignment.

Students will not be permitted into class without proper attire and hair worn in a bun or other style off the neck with bangs pulled back.

Payment Plans: Tuition can be paid on a quarterly payment plan. Payment received after the due date is subject to a \$10 late fee.

Make-Up Classes: Missed classes must be made up during the same payment period and cannot be carried over to the next period.

Family Discount: RSB offers a 25% discount to families with multiple students at the studio. The dancer with the largest tuition pays the full amount. Each direct family member after receives the discount.
